Passage : After reading the passage write out the verse that stood out the most to you.

E

Engage: Go back and read the passage again. Highlight important words or concepts. Look up definitions for specific words. Use the following questions to guide you: Who is the audience? Are there cause and effect relationships? Attributes of God? Promises of God?

A

Art: Draw out your verse. It doesn't have to be perfect.

R

Reflect on the passage of scripture that you read. What did you learn? What stood out to you about the passage? How could you apply what you've learned to your life.

L

Listen: Take a few minutes to sit quietly before the Lord. What is he saying to you through this verse? Write it down.

S

Speak: Take this time to pray to the Lord. Use the scripture in your prayer if possible.
